

All campers receive the same camp experience regardless of what families pay. We are doing this to continue to provide a high-quality and affordable Christian experience for all campers.

- Tier One (T1) is the rate we are able to offer, thanks to our donors.
- Tier Two (T2) is a partially supported rate for families that can pay more than tier 1.
- Tier Three (T3) most closely represents the actual cost of camp, including staffing, meals, facilities, and programming.



Choosing tiers two and three actively supports the true cost of the camp experience, enabling Camp Luther to direct donor gifts to support various projects and facility upgrades.
